Introduction

- Revival involves the proclamation of God's Word and the mobilization of God's people.
- Early reforms under Ezra—Ezra 7-10
- The lapse back into the old patterns between Ezra and Nehemiah.
- The time for spiritual revival is NOW!

Spiritual Revival

A. General: PATTERN for Revival—Nehemiah 8-10

- 1. Begins with the **Proclamation** of God's Word—Nehemiah 8
- 2. Deepens with the **Confession** of Sin—Nehemiah 9
- 3. Solidifies by the **Commitments** we make—Nehemiah 10

B. Specific: Step One—Proclamation —Nehemiah 8:1-8

- 1. The PEOPLE who wanted to hear God's Word—v. 1
 - a. Initiated the revival
 - b. United as "one man"
 - c. Spiritually Hungry

2. The PASTORS who proclaimed God's Word—v. 2, 4, 7-8

- a. Ezra the Priest—the main speaker
 - 1) Professionally qualified—Ezra 7:10
 - 2) Practically qualified—Ezra 8:22-23
 - The Levites—the "assistant pastors"—v. 4, 7-8

3. The PROCLAMATION of God's Word—vv. 2-8

- a. The Time and Make-up of the assembly
- The PROGRAM—Order of Service
 - 1) Prayer—vv. 5-6
 - 2) Public Reading of God's Word—v. 3
 - a) 5 to 6 hours standing
 - b) Public reading of God's Word today-- 1 Timothy 4:13
 - 3) Explanation of God's Word—vv. 7-8
 - a) "Read distinctively"—translated it into the language of the people.
 - b) "Gave the sense" so people could understand.
