Standing Strong, Standing Firm in the Lord's Strength (Eph 6:10-11)

- Christians easily defeated: they aren't serious about their warfare
- Paul has just shown what the Spirit filled home community looks like
- In His last word of council, he tells us we are in warfare against Satan
 I. A Call to Stand Up in God's Strength & Fight for the Lord (6:10-13)
- "Finally," –"for the rest" Paul's conclusion is based on all he said already

 David an illustration of 'Be strong in the Lord' (1 Sam 30:6b)
 - A. To be strong in the Lord, you must be "in the Lord."

 Shamah, Son of Agee 2 Sam 23:11-12; Isa 11:5; 59:17; Rom 13:14
 - B. To be strong in the Lord: "you must know your own weakness."
 - C. To be strong in the Lord, you must know the Lord's strength.
 - II. Put on God's full Armor to Stand firm Against the Enemy (6:11)
 - A. Standing firm against the enemy: result of putting on God's full armor
 - B. Stand firm against the enemy by growing in Biblical Understanding.
 - (i) Understand God's full provision.
 - (ii) 'Understand Satan's schemes.
 - (iii) Understand where to stand firm and where to be forbearing
 - C. Stand firm against the enemy with biblical practice.
