12 Principles Biblically Derived Upon Present Matters

- 1. That when a people are under God's judgement, their fears become irrational. *Lev 26:14,17,36; Cf. Deut 32:19-31a; Isa 30:17*
- 2. That fear of death makes people lifelong slaves, and this is the hallmark of the devil's children.

Heb 2:14-15

3. That the whole world lies in the power of the evil one, and this diseases and biases all their earthly occupations and sciences.

1 John 5:19; Cf. Ps 111:10; Prov 1:7

4. That never, aside from corporal punishment, is a civil authority allowed to require a bodily imposition upon another, but only voluntarily.

Ex 21:2-6; Cf. Rev 13:11-17

5. That quarantining is only for the demonstrably sick.

Lv 13:1-4, 46; Cf. Lv 14:43-46

- 6. That failure to fence in an ox who is known to be dangerous is punishable with death. *Ex 21:28-30*
- 7. That adding to the commands of God is great wickedness. *Deut 4:1-2; Cf Mk 12:31*
- 8. That the Christian is commanded to test all things, rather than to blindly trust the so-called experts.

1 Thess 5:21; Cf. Acts 17:11

9. That the Christian is not to render to Caesar the things that are God's.

Luke 20:21-26

10. That as Christians, we are to speak the truth one to another.

Eph 4:25

11. That truth is viewed as a national security threat in the eyes of a God-hating nation.

12. That Scripture prophesies of a day in which men enrich themselves by deceiving the nations with so-called medicine that results in death.
