Introduction: 1 Corinthians 11:25 In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

Characteristic #1 Made by God Completed by God. **8a, 10a**

Characteristic #2 Made with Israel. **8b, 10a**

Characteristic #3 Not an extension or revision of the Old. **9a 13**

Characteristic #4 Was not conditional. **8:10b-, 12**

Characteristic #5 Promised a new heart. 10b Ezekiel 11:17–20; 36:26–27

The people of Israel were determined to be obedient. Exodus 19:8; 24:7

Deuteronomy 6:4–9.

Deut.5:27–29

Characteristic #6 Promise of a personal experience of God. 10c

Exodus 6:7 While Israel was still in captivity in Egypt, God had promised the people of Israel that I will be your God and you shall be My people.

Judges 2:10 All that generation also were gathered to their fathers; and there arose another generation after them who did not know the LORD, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel.

Hosea 4:1 Listen to the word of the LORD, O sons of Israel, For the LORD has a case against the inhabitants of the land, Because there is no faithfulness or kindness Or knowledge of God in the land. **6** My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being My priest. Since you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Characteristic #7 Promise of complete forgiveness. 12

Characteristic #8 The promise is for today. 13

Obsolete: unserviceable, outmoded.

1 Samuel 8:1 And it came about when Samuel was old that he appointed his sons judges over Israel.
