

The Story of Judas

Matthew 27:3-5 Then when Judas, who had betrayed Him, saw that He had been condemned, he felt remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." But they said, "What is that to us? See to that yourself!" And he threw the pieces of silver into the temple sanctuary and departed; and he went away and hanged himself.

Matthew 26:24 The Son of Man is to go, just as it is written of Him; but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born.

John 17:12 While I was with them, I was keeping them in Your name which You have given Me; and I guarded them and not one of them perished but the son of perdition, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.

Acts 1:15-20 [Peter] said, "Brethren, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit foretold by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. For he was counted among us and received his share in this ministry." (Now this man acquired a field with the price of his wickedness, and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his intestines gushed out. And it became known to all who were living in Jerusalem; so that in their own language that field was called Hakeldama, that is, Field of Blood.) "For it is written in the book of Psalms, 'Let his homestead be made desolate, and let no one dwell in it'; and, 'Let another man take his office.'"

John 13:21-30

Luke 6:12-16 [Jesus] spent the whole night in prayer to God. And when day came, He called His disciples to Him and chose twelve of them, whom He also named apostles.... [including] Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor.

Matthew 10:1-5 [Jesus] gave them authority ... [including] Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed Him.... These twelve Jesus sent out.

John 6:66-71 As a result of this many of His disciples withdrew and were not walking with Him anymore. So Jesus said to the twelve, "You do not want to go away also, do you?" Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life. "We have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God." Jesus answered them, "Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve, and yet one of you is a devil?" Now He meant Judas the son of Simon Iscariot, for he, one of the twelve, was going to betray Him.

John 13:10-11 Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." For He knew the one who was betraying Him; for this reason He said, "Not all of you are clean."

Matthew 26:6-9 Now when Jesus was in Bethany, at the home of Simon the leper, a woman came to Him with an alabaster vial of very costly perfume, and she poured it on His head as He reclined at the table. But the disciples were indignant when they saw this, and said, "Why this waste? For this perfume might have been sold for a high price and the money given to the poor."

John 12:1-6 Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany.... Mary then took a pound of very costly perfume of pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus.... Then Judas Iscariot said 'Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii and given to poor people? Now he said this, not because he we concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it.

Matthew 26:14-16 Then one of the twelve, named Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, "What are you willing to give me to betray Him to you?" And they weighed out thirty pieces of silver to him. From then on he began looking for a good opportunity to betray Jesus.

Luke 22:1-3 The Passover was approaching ... and Satan entered into Judas ... and he went away and discussed with the chief priests and officers how he might betray Him.

John 13:2 During supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray him...

John 13:27 After the morsel, Satan then entered in to him.

Matthew 26:20-25 Jesus said, "Truly I say to you that one of you will betray Me." Being deeply grieved, they each one began to say to Him, "Surely not I, Lord?" ... And Judas, who was betraying Him, said, "Surely it is not I, Rabbi?" Jesus said to him, "You have said it yourself."

John 13:27b-28 Therefore Jesus said to him, "What you do, do quickly." Now no one of those reclining at the table knew for what purpose He had said this to him.

Luke 22:2, 6 The chief priests and scribes were seeking how they might put Him to death; for they were afraid of the people.... [Judas] began seeking a good opportunity to betray Him to them apart from the crowd.

John 18:2 Now Judas also, who was betraying Him, knew the place.

Matthew 26:30, 36, 47-50 They went out to the Mount of Olives.... Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane.... Judas, one of the twelve, came up accompanied by a large crowd with swords and clubs, who came from the chief priests and elders of the people. Now he who was betraying Him gave them a sign, saying, "Whomever I kiss, He is the one; seize Him." Immediately Judas went to Jesus and said, "Hail, Rabbi!" and kissed Him. And Jesus said to him, "Friend, do what you have come for." Then they came and laid hands on Jesus and seized Him.
