

Hallelujah! Christ Will Return

Revelation 19:1-10

- 1) God's people shout *Hallelujah!*
 - a) *Halēlû* (praise) + *yâ* (Yah)—from *Yahweh* (Heb. יהוה)
 - b) From the martyrs in heaven (19:1-3)
 - c) From the 24 elders before God's throne (19:4)
 - d) From the great multitude (19:6)
- 2) There will be a wedding when Christ returns (19:7-9)
 - a) Betrothed (elected), presented (at Rapture), married (at second advent)
 - b) A Groom (Christ), a bride (the Church), & invited guests (OT, Trib. & millennial saints)
- 3) Only Christians can have lasting hope of celebration
 - a) *God has conquered evil* (19:1-2)
 - b) *The Lord God Almighty reigns* (19:3-6)
 - c) *Christ will return* (19:7-8)
 - d) *Feasting awaits!* (19:9; cf. Matt. 26:29)
 - e) *God's words can be trusted* (19:9)
 - f) *God alone is to be worshiped* (19:10)
