GOD'S COVENANTS

God made a covenant with Adam, which Adam transgressed. *Yet God promised to end the curse thru the woman's offspring.*

God made a covenant with Abram, which Abram believed— God promised to bless all nations through Abram's offspring.

God made a covenant with Israel at Sinai (mediated by Moses); *obedience would lead to blessing and unfaithfulness to curse*.

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Scripture Reading

GALATIANS 3:15–29

THE MAIN POINT OF GALATIANS 3:15–29

The law's fundamental purpose is to compel people to trust Jesus for salvation.

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- 4. *Consider their nature.* God's covenant with Abraham was a promise to be believed; the covenant at Sinai was a law to be obeyed.
- 5. *Consider their power*. God's covenant with Abraham could give life; the law was impotent to empower obedience or to give new life.

"The law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith."
