"disciples" Gk mathetes; 'learner, apprentice, adherent.' (used 63x in John)

"followed Jesus" Gk akoloutheo; 'come after, accompany, follow.'

If you want God to lead you out, you must be willing to follow!

What does that mean, *Follow Me*? What or Who is it that draws them?

Following Christ means devoting your whole heart to Him and dedicating your entire life to His service.

'To follow one who precedes; in union with; to walk the same road.' (Thayer's; Strong's)

- 2) Personal Gain (e.g., financial, material, positional; 'fire insurance')
- 3) Wonder & Excitement (i.e., a whim or a lark; drawn by popularity)
