



## Consequences of Sin

Genesis 3:14–19

1. Serpents remind us of Satan's curse (3:14-15)
  - a. Responsible for his craftiness (cf. Exod 21:28; Lev 20:15-16)
  - b. Shamed for his actions (Ps 72:9; Micah 7:17)
  - c. Enmity & hostility w/ man (cf. Jn 8:44; 1 Jn 3:8)
2. Family problems remind us of woman's discipline for sin (3:16)
3. Drought, weeds, famine remind us of man's discipline for sin (3:17-19)
4. Death reminds us that we are all sinners (Rom 5:12)
5. Christ reminds us that He is the Seed of the woman (3:15; Gal 3:16; cf. Gen 15:5)
  - a. He became a curse for us (Gal 3:13)
    - i. Man of sorrows, acquainted w/ grief, wounded, bruised, punished for us (Isa 53:3-5)... God was pleased to crush him (53:10)
    - ii. Cursed thorns on His head (Mark 15:17)
    - iii. Sweated drops of blood (Luke 22:44).
    - iv. Prayers & pleas w/ strong crying & tears (Heb 5:7)
  - b. In Adam all die; in Christ all shall be made alive (1 Cor 15:22)
  - c. Jesus made to be sin for us (2 Cor 5:21)
  - d. Christ condemned sin in the flesh (Rom 8:3)
  - e. Jesus reigns until He puts all His enemies under His feet (1 Cor 15:25)
  - f. The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet (16:20)
