Thoughts for Sabbath Meditation and Discussion:

- 1. What does the society you live in consider to be beautiful? Read 1 Peter 3:3-4. What is incorruptibly beautiful in the sight of God? What does a gentle/meek and quiet/tranquil soul look like?
- 2. Read 1 Timothy 2:9. What does this teach about the way women ought to dress?
- 3. Read Proverbs 7:10-13. What are some of the characteristics of the immoral woman?
- 4. Question 71 of the WSC reads: "What is required in the seventh commandment? The seventh commandment requires the preservation of our own and <u>our neighbor's chastity</u>, in heart, speech, and behavior." Why do women especially need to consider men to be their "neighbor" with regard to how modestly they dress?
- 5. Read Ephesians 5:22-24. What does "submit" mean? Read Proverbs 21:9; 21:19; 25:24; 27:15.
- 6. Read Proverbs 12:4; 14:1. What does "the crown of her husband" mean? What does "rottenness in his bones" mean? What does "builds her house" mean? What does "pulls it down with her hands" mean?
- 7. Read Titus 2:3-5. What are the characteristics of the older godly woman? What are they to teach the younger women? What does the last phrase of v5 teach about the consequences of failure to be and do these things?
- 8. Read Colossians 3:19. What does this teach men about the way they are to treat women especially husbands toward their wives?
- 9. Read Proverbs 31:10-31. What is this "virtuous wife" like?
