Boots for the Battle (Ephesians 6:15)

- I. Stand firm against the enemy, Prepared with Boots of Gospel of peace
- 1. Be prepared with the boots of the gospel of peace, we must understand the gospel so we can defend it against attack
 - a. The Gospel is under attack from "Christian" psychology, which denies the sufficiency of Christ & the gospel
 - b. The Gospel is under attack from the modern evangelical church & its "seeker sensitive Christianity."
 - c. The Gospel is under attack from the postmodern and humanistic views of the emerging church.
- II. To be prepared with the boots of the gospel of peace, we must have appropriated message personally.
- a. Appropriating the gospel personally begins with repentance from sin & faith in Christ alone for salvation.
- b. Appropriating the gospel personally continues with preaching the gospel to your own soul.
 - i. Preaching the gospel to your own soul increases your love for God, for others, and for the lost.
 - ii. Preaching the gospel to your own soul humbles your pride
 - iii. Preaching the gospel to your own soul causes you to glorify God in all things, including your trials
- c. Appropriating the gospel personally brings the peace of Christ practically into your daily life.
 - i. First, it brings us peace with God
 - ii. The gospel brings us peace with one another
