Sermon Text: Romans 11:1-16 Salvation Has Come to the Gentiles

God rules history in the hope of salvation.

1) God's saving purpose for the Jewish nation

- a) The Remnant of Grace
 - i) Elijah and the Seven Thousand (11:2-4)
 - ii) Paul and the Jewish Christians (11:5-6)
 - (1) Not on the basis of works
 - (2) By grace
- b) The Hardening of Israel
 - i) Senseless Toward God (11:7-8)
 - ii) Privilege Turned to Destruction (11:9-10)
- c) Application: God is sovereign in election and reprobation.

2) God's saving purpose for the Gentile Christians

- a) The Salvation of Gentiles through Israel's Hardening (11;11-12)
- b) The Provoking of Israel through Gentile Salvation (11:13-14)
- c) **Application**: God creates longing for Him in the elect.

3) God's saving purpose for the world

- a) The Reconciliation of the World (11:15a)
- b) The Resurrection of the Dead (11:15b)
- c) Application: God rules history in hope.
