• God's Divine Purpose Is To Judge The Wicked In Righteousness By The Agency Of His People, (vs. 1 – 5)

1. God's Command Is For His People To Go Into The Hostile World & Confront It With The Gospel, (vs. 1)

1.1) God's Call Is For Us To Engage Immediately In The Battle

"You Are To Cross (Act.Part) Over"-

""I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me." (John 17:20–23, ESV)

1.2) God's Comfort Is That He Is Mightier Than All

"Dispossess Nations - Greater & Mightier"-

"Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."" (Matthew 16:16–19, ESV)

1.3) God's Commission Is To Advance His Kingdom In Real Time

To Heaven"- "Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory.
