- 2. We are reminded of God's special relationship to the poor Matt. 5:3; Lk. 6:20; James 2:5
- C. And the slander of those saying they are Jews
 - C². Those saying they are Jews But are not, but are a synagogue of Satan John 8:31-47

III. Encouragements (10)

- A. Do not fear what you are about to suffer
 - 1. One of our great exhortations in Scripture! Matt. 10:28
 - 2. Remember the vv from Isaiah, tied to the First/Last Cf. Isa 41:10; 44:2; 48:13

- A. The one having ears, he must hear what the Spirit says to the churches
- B. The one overcoming shall not be hurt by the second death Second death eternal punishment, lake of fire
