- 6. How did Jesus answer the objection of the Jews (vv. 14-18)?
- 7. How did the Jews respond to Jesus' statement that the Father sent Him and bears witness to Him (v. 19a)? How did Jesus answer (v. 19b)?
- 8. What other perplexing statement did Jesus make to His audience (v. 21)?
- 9. What did the Jews think Jesus might do (v. 22)?
- 10. Where did Jesus say that He was from (and to where He was going) whereas everyone else was not (v. 23)?
- 11. Why will people die in their sins (v. 24)?
- 12. What was Jesus talking about that the Jews still did not understand (vv. 24-27)?
- 13. What would point people to Jesus' identity? What specifically will people learn about Jesus (v. 28a)?
- 14. How do Jesus' statements and explanations in this passage relate to the Fifth Commandment?
- 15. How does the Fifth Commandment show us Christ?
- 16. What does the Apostle Paul teach in Romans 1 about people who despise authority?
- 17. As the incarnate Son and anointed Messiah, Jesus obeyed and submitted to the will of the Father by accomplishing redemption. His role as the suffering servant shows us His obedience. What about Christ's person and work shows us His authority authority that the Fifth Commandment enjoins?
