Sermon Outline for Sunday, December 18, 2022

Sermon: We Don't Walk in Circles!. "The Faithful Outcasts" Pt.4

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Deuteronomy 6:1-8*

New Covenant: *Hebrews 1:6-14*

II Doctrine:

We must cling to the salvation message of our final authority Jesus the Messiah. Our Lord's sovereign message regarding the Gospel must never be compromised. All of our faculties, (heart, mind, soul, and strength) must be dedicated to the message of our King. We are to be outcasts for the gospel of Christ.

The gospel message is what the law of God was pointing us to. The punishment was strict for those who rejected God's word in the Old Testament. How much worse will the judgment be for those who reject the gospel message brought by God himself! Those who reject the gospel will be left wandering in the desert of the world system until death.

Miracles are a unique time stamp in history to authenticate God's word. The Apostles were given the power to perform miracles for God's glory not their own. The unique miracles performed to show the people the message could be trusted.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

1) We must cling to the salvation message of our final authority Jesus the Messiah. Our Lord's sovereign message regarding the Gospel must never be compromised. All of our faculties, (heart, mind, soul, and strength) must be dedicated to the message of our King. We are to be outcasts for the gospel of Christ. (*Hebrews 2:1; Deuteronomy 6:1-8; Mark 12:28-34*)

2) The gospel message is what the law of God was pointing us to. The punishment was strict for those who rejected God's word in the Old Testament. How much worse will the judgment be for those who reject the gospel message brought by God himself! Those who reject the gospel will be left wandering in the desert of the world system until death. (*Hebrews:2:2,3; Galatians 1:6-10*)

3) Miracles are a unique time stamp in history to authenticate God's word. The Apostles were given the power to perform miracles for God's glory not their own. The unique miracles were performed to show the people the message could be trusted. (*Hebrews 2:4; John 10:31-38*)
