[3] You have multiplied the nation;
you have increased its joy;
they rejoice before you
as with joy at the harvest,
as they are glad when they divide the spoil.

WHAT IS ADVENT?

- 'advent' = coming or arrival
- Advent is a season of waiting.
- As we remember the first coming of Christ, we remember he is coming again.
- Hope, Peace, Joy, Love, and Christ
- Today we turn to the word <u>JOY</u>.

INTRODUCTION

The story of moving from darkness to <u>light</u> is the story of the gospel; it's the story of Christmas; it's the story of the Book of Isaiah.

Isaiah 7:23–25–[23] In that day every place where there used to be a thousand vines, worth a thousand shekels of silver, will become briers and thorns. [24] With bow and arrows a man will come there, for all the land will be briers and thorns. [25] And as for all the hills that used to be hoed with a hoe, you will not come there for fear of briers and thorns, but they will become a place where cattle are let loose and where sheep tread.

Isaiah 9:1–2–[1] But there will be no gloom for her who was in anguish. In the former time he brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he has made glorious the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations.

[2] The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone.

Psalm 30:5

[5] For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime.
Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

[2] "Enlarge the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; do not hold back; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes.
[3] For you will spread abroad to the right and to the left, and your offspring will possess the nations and will people the desolate cities.

Romans 5:15–[15] But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.

John 10:16–[16] And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.

Psalm 16:11
