**Daniel 5:5-9**

**I. Doctrine: *Handwriting On the Wall* Elicits Great \_\_\_\_\_ In

*sible* (*to* sinners), vv. 8-9

**III. Why *Handwriting On the Wall* Does Not \_\_\_\_\_  
Christ’s *Atoned-For* Church**

A. –*Because* we \_\_\_\_\_ *Enjoy* The *Fruits* of Christ,  
and His Universal *Victory*; . . . , (Eph. 1:3-10)

B. . . . And, *IN Him*, we \_\_\_\_\_ *Anticipate* The *Rest*  
of History, (Php. 1:6)

**Key Phrase**—v. 5a: “*Immediately the fingers of a human hand appeared and wrote on the plaster of the wall of the king’s palace, opposite the lampstand. . . .*” (ESV)
