 - -v. 38: reason why Jesus won't cast out those who come to Him
 - -v. 39: the Father's will from the divine perspective
 - -v. 40: the Father's will from the human perspective

Practical Lessons

- 1) Jesus' confidence in the success of His mission was predestinarian in nature.
- 2) Jesus saw no conflict between divine sovereignty and human responsibility (Matt. 11:27, 28).
- 3) If you haven't already done so, look to Jesus and trust in Him.
- 4) If you have looked to Jesus and trusted in Him, then worship Him.
