Deuteronomy 6:4 4 “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! (NKJV)

1 Peter 1:3 3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ ... (NKJV)

Hebrews 1:8 8 But to the Son *He* says: “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. (NKJV)

Acts 5:3-4 3 But Peter said, “Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back *part* of the price of the land for yourself? 4 ... You have not lied to men but to God.” (NKJV)

WCF 2.3 In the unity of the Godhead there be three Persons of one substance, power, and eternity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost. The Father is of none, neither begotten nor proceeding; the Son is eternally begotten of the Father; the Holy Ghost eternally proceeding from the Father and the Son.
