REVIEW ...

A. The bad news: For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God (Rom. 3)

B. The good news: For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son (John 3:16)

## HOW WILL I BE SAVED THROUGH CHRIST? OR HOW CAN I BECOME A PARTAKER OF THIS SALVATION IN CHRIST?

- A. Answer from our side is saving faith: John 3:15; 16, 18, 36, 6:47; 20:31
  - 1. A simple definition of saving faith: Faith in Jesus Christ is a saving grace, whereby we receive and rest upon Jesus alone for salvation, as He is offered to us in the Gospel. (Westminster H Cat. Q. 21)
    - a. God sends His captains (preachers) to rebellious Mansoul
    - b. In His Name they offer peace and pardon upon surrender and return
      see example of this in Isaiah 55:1-9
      - take note of 'verbs' describing our response to His message
    - 2. How you respond to Gospel of Jesus Christ is matter of life and death!
      - a. John 3:36 6:47 Acts 16:30-31
        - do not reason these solemn truths away
        - instead, wrestle (!) in prayer with the Gospel of Acts 5:30-32
- B. Answer from God's side is new birth or regeneration (John 1:13; 3:3-8)
  - 1. This act of God is secret mysterious irresistible sovereign powerful a. the result of this act is the creation of new (spiritual) life
  - 2. God works this new birth through His Word: James 1:18; 1 Pet 1:23
    - a. since God works this 'new birth' through His chosen means of the Word, He commands you to be *busy in and with HIS Word*

- F. How are these two (regeneration and faith) related?
  - 1. They are in an inseparable relationship (John 5:25)
  - 2. They are in a **cause & effect relationship** with *regeneration the cause and* faith the effect
    - a. see John 3:5; John 6:44 & 65 Acts 16:14 18:27 Eph. 1:19-20 Eph. 2:8 Phil 1:29 and opposite: 1 Cor. 2:14
    - b. this 'cause-effect' is also glad tidings (Eph. 2:4-5, 8)
  - 3. They grow into a **conscious relationship** (Matt. 7:20; Col. 1:12-13)
    - a. though new birth precedes the new spiritual life in God's order
    - b. the new life precedes the knowledge of new birth in the experience
