I. Felonious – "then shall that lawless one" (v. 8)

He will be:

- A. Disclosed "then shall that Wicked be revealed"
- B. Defeated -"whom the Lord will consume with the spirit"

II. Fake - "with all deceivableness" (vs. 9-10)

He uses:

- A. Inspiration "after the working of Satan"
- **B.** Imitation- "with all power, signs, and lying wonders"
- C. Illusion "deception of wickedness in them that perish"

III. F aithless - "for this cause God shall send them" (vs. 11-12) They choose to:

- A. Receive -"they will believe a lie"
- B. Reject "who believe not the truth"
- *C.* **Revel** "had pleasure in unrighteousness"
