    - Suffering In The Lives Of His Children:
      - To Prepare Them And To Prepare You:
        - For The Glory:
          - You Will Experience:
            - In Your Eternal Life!
      - **IE:** Like Using Fire To Refine:
        - And Purify Precious Metals!
  - But This Is A Difficult Truth:
    - For Those Who Belong To The Lord!
      - This Is A Hard Pill To Swallow!
        - And I'm Sure The Apostle Paul:
          - Struggled With This Truth:
            - In His Own Heart And Life Too!
- 4. But Then He Wrote The Very Next Verse:
  - 8:18 Which Says:
    - "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us!"
      - God Revealed To Paul:
        - So That He Could Reveal To Us:
          - That Any Suffering You May Go Through In This World:
            - That God Uses To Refine You & Purify You & Prepare You For Glory:
              - Is *Nothing* Compared To That Glory! His Glory!

- When You Go Through:
  - "The Sufferings Of This Present Time" At Times:
    - It Seems So Dark!
      - You Wonder If There Is Any Light At The End Of That Tunnel!
- Do You Remember The Words Of This Song?
  - O Soul Are You Weary And Troubled?

No Light In The Darkness You See?

There's Light For A Look At The Savior!

And Life For Abundant And Free!

- Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus!

Look Full In His Wonderful Face!

And The Things Of Earth Will Grow Strangely Dim,

In The Light Of His Glory And Grace!

- You See The Light:
  - Of "His Glory" Will Become:
    - The Light Of Your Own Glory:
      - When 8:18 That Glory "Shall Be Revealed In Us!"
  - This Glory Is Not Just:
    - The Glory Of Christ:
      - That Will Be Seen By You!
  - This Glory Is:
    - The Glory Of Christ:
      - That Will Be Shared With You!
  - The Apostle John Puts It This Way:
    - In 1 John 3:2 "Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is!"
- And The Light Of This Glory:
  - Far Exceeds The Darkness Of Suffering:
    - It Is "Not [Even] Worthy To Be Compared!"
  - Because Your Suffering:
    - Is Only Temporary But:
      - Your Glory:
        - Will Be Timeless!
- Is It Any Wonder That:
  - In 2 Corinthians 4:17-18 Paul Also Wrote About This:
    - And Said "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; / While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal!"
  - Christian There Is Light:
    - Even In Your Suffering Today!
      - Let This Be A "Light-Bulb" Moment For You Like It Was:
        - For Paul!
  - 8:18 "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us!"
    - And This Glory:
      - Is So Great:
        - That Paul Wants Us To Think About It:
          - A Bit More!
  - So In 8:19-22 He Adds:
    - "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. / For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected [the same] in hope, / Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. / For we know that the whole creation

groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now!" - The Glory You Have: - As A Child Of God - Both Now & Forever: - Is So Great: - That Even Creation Itself: - Is Looking For It & Longing For It: - Along With You! - So - Not Only Is There: - A Light In Suffering: There Is [Also] A Longing Through Suffering! 2. - Which Is What We Find: - In 8:19-21 - Where Our Attention Is Turned: - To The "Earnest Expectation Of The Creature" - Which Is: - Creation Itself! - There Has Been A Lot Of Ink Spilled On Paper & Papyrus: - To Explain What These Verses Mean! - But - The Most Consistent Explanation: - Is That Paul Is Describing: - The Natural Creation: - Of God! - His Creation Apart From Angelic And Human Beings! - And He Personifies Creation: - By Giving It: - Feelings And Desires: - Just Like Our Own! - And He Does This: - Again - To Show Us Just How Great Our Glory Is! - It Is So Great That: - Its As If Creation Itself: - Is Groaning For It! - And So - We See In 8:19: - The Present Desire: - Of Creation! - "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God!" - Here - All Of God's Creation: - Is Pictured As: - Watching! - It Has An "Earnest Expectation!" - The Original Word Translated Here: - Means To Look For Something: - With An Outstretched Head! - It's Like You Are: - Straining Your Neck: - To See Something That Is Coming From A Distance! - IE: Like What I Saw People Doing At The Train Stations In Italy Last Year! They Know The Train Is Coming - They Are Just Looking To See If Its Close! - In A Similar Way: - Creation Is Pictured As: - Straining Its Neck: - To Watch For Something It Knows Is Coming! - Something Far Better: - Than It Sees Around It: - Right Now! - But - Is Also: -Waiting! - It - 8:19 - "Waiteth For The Manifestation Of The Sons Of God!" - Just Like We Are Waiting For:

- Our Future Glory:
  - So Is Creation Itself!
- It Is Longing For:
  - The Full Revelation:
    - The "Apocalypse" Of:
      - God's Children! Of Believers In Christ!
- Why? "Material Nature Is Metaphorically In Sympathy With Redeemed Man, And Shall Be Restored With Him!" (William Shedd)
- So God's Creation Is Given:
  - Life And Feeling:
    - To Show How We Ought To:
      - Long For This "Manifestation" As Well!
  - Because If God Cares:
    - For His Creation:
      - Enough To Restore It:
        - From Its Fallen Condition!
  - Doesn't God Care For:
    - His Children:
      - That Much More?
- But Paul Continues!
  - And The Longing Of Creation:
    - Is Based On:
- The Past Degradation:
  - Which We Find In:
    - 8:20 "For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected [the same] in hope!"
      - When Adam & Eve:
        - Committed The First Human Sin:
          - In The Garden Of Eden:
            - It Did Not Just Affect Them!
  - It Infected All Of Their Children:
    - 5:12 "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned!"
      - But Even More:
  - It Impacted All Of Creation!
    - Genesis 3:17-19 "And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; / Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; / In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return!"
  - According To Genesis:
    - God Himself Is The One Who:
      - "Cursed" The Ground Of His Creation:
        - And Was The One Who:
          - "Subjected" It:
            - "To Vanity!"
    - So That Now All Of Creation:
      - Because Of The Curse Experiences:
  - Frailty!
    - This Earth Is Frail!
      - Just Like Sin Ages Man:
        - The Sin Of Man Has Aged The Earth!
    - It Saps The Life Out Of It!
      - **IE:** Debate Old Earth / Young Earth Creation 6,000 Years *Is* Old For An Earth Forced To Contend With Sin!
    - Remember First Murder Cain & Able Genesis 4:10 God To Cain "What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground!"

- How Much More Blood Cries Out From The Ground? Innocent Blood! - Even Christ's Blood! - Also - Because Of The Curse: - All Of Creation Experiences: - Fruitlessness! - Many Times - This Old Earth: - Fails To Produce Its Fruit! - IE: Sometimes With Too Much Rain! Sometimes With Too Little Rain! At The Beginning - It Was Not So - It Was Watered Just Right By The Lord Himself! - Also - Because Of The Curse: - All Of Creation Experiences: - Some Translations - Instead Of "Vanity": - "Frustration!" - But Why Would Creation Be Frustrated? - Same Reason You Might Be! - You Don't Get To Fulfill Your Purpose Or Potential! - God Created This World: - To Bless Man - But Also: - To Glorify Himself! - But For Now: - Creation Will Have To Wait: - Until Its Own Redemption And Restoration! - Because - Even Though God: - "Subjected" His Creation To: - "Vanity" - He Still Did So: - "In Hope!" - God Had A Plan In Place: - Not Only To Redeem: - Fallen Man - Through The Gospel! - That Plan Includes: - The Restoration: - Of This Old, Cursed Earth! - And So - God's Creation Is Given: - Hope In: - The Future Deliverance: - That We Read About In: - 8:21 - "Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God!" - When God Fully Glorifies: - His Children - Body, Soul, Spirit: - At The Second Coming Of Jesus Christ: - God Will Also: - Reverse The Curse: - On Creation!

    - Delivered!

  - Not The Bondage:
    - Of Its Own Sin!
  - But The Bondage:
    - From The Effects:
      - Of Our Sin!
- Revelation 22:3 "And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it: and his servants shall serve him!"
  - And So All Of Creation Will Also Be:
- Delivered To:

- "The Glorious Liberty Or The Liberty Of Glory Of The Children Of God!"
- When The Curse Of The Earth:
  - Is Reversed:
    - It Will No Longer Be:
      - Frail, Fruitless, Futile!
  - Instead The Purpose For Its Creation:
    - Will Finally & Forever Be:
      - Fulfilled!
  - A Picture Of This New Earth:
    - In The Kingdom Of Christ:
      - Is Given To Us In Several Passages Including:
  - Isaiah 11:6-9 "The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. / And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. / And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den. / They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea!"

  - Has To Look Forward To:
    - Imagine Christian:
      - What You Have To Look Forward To!
  - If Creation:
    - Will Be Redeemed And Restored:
      - In Glory Just Think About:
        - What Your Final Redemption And Restoration:
          - Will Be Like!
  - Because If God Cares For:
    - His Creation In This Way:
      - How Much More:
        - Does He Care For You:
          - As His Child!
  - And If Creation Looks For & Longs For:
    - This Glory How Much More:
      - Can & Should You!
        - And That Leads Us To See That:
- 3. There Is A Lesson From Suffering!
  - Which Is What We Find In:
    - 8:22 "For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now!"
      - Once Again All Of God's Creation:
        - Is Personified:
          - As If It Is Moaning And Groaning:
            - For The Reverse Of Its Curse!
    - But There Is I Believe:
      - A Physical Dimension:
        - To This Figurative Language!
          - The Earth Does, Indeed:
  - Groan In Grief!
    - Grief For Its Own Involuntary Suffering:
      - Of Sin And Sinners:
        - That Have Inhabited It And:
          - Have Exploited It:
            - From The Time Of The Fall Until Now!
    - **IE:** Its Like When You Breath A Heavy Sigh When You Pick Up Something Heavy That You Probably Shouldn't Have!
      - In Mark 13:8 Jesus Said That:
        - "There shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: these are the beginnings of sorrows!"

- In Matthew 24:7 It Is Recorded That:
  - "There shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places!"
- Though God Is Sovereign:
  - Over All Of These Earthly Troubles:
    - Yet They Give Expression To The Frailty & Frustration:
      - Of This Old World!
- The Other Picture Given:
  - Is That Through These Ways:
    - The Earth:
- Travails For Glory!
  - **IE:** It Is Experiencing Something Like The Birth-Pains Of A Mother! But They Are Pains As John Calvin Once Pointed Out "Pains Of Birth, Not Death!"
    - After All Jesus Said In:
      - Luke 21:25, 28 "And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring!"
        - "And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh!"
- This Is The Lesson:
  - Not Just From Your Own Suffering:
    - But From The Suffering:
      - Of Creation Itself!
  - Even The Grief:
    - Of Creation:
      - Cannot Compare:
        - With Its Future Glory!
