GENESIS 2:18–25

THE MAIN POINT OF GENESIS 2:18–25

Understanding God's good design for human relationships—especially his design for marriage—is crucial for human flourishing.

Marriage in Eden

- 1. God designed humans to live and flourish in relationship with others; he didn't create us to live in isolation (verse 18).
- 2. God designed most adults to be married and human society to flourish (verses 18-25).

Definition:

Marriage is covenant relationship in which one man and one woman publicly promise each other their exclusive, lifelong, wholeperson love, and thereby establish a new family in the community.

Marriage in Eden

- 1. God designed humans to live and flourish in relationship with others; he didn't create us to live in isolation (verse 18).
- 2. God designed most adults to be married and human society to flourish (verses 18-25).
 - a. Marriage is complementary, and it's the God-designed context for having and raising children.
 - b. Marriage is a covenant of life-long love, and, by God's design, it reflects Christ's inseparable love for his church.
 - c. Marriage involves community recognition of a new family—a new team to colabor in fulfilling God's responsibilities in life.
