FURTHER CONSIDERATIONS

Ephesians 3:14-19

To whom does Paul pray? What are the specifics of Paul's request for the Ephesian believers in these verses? In v. 17, Paul desires that Christ would be at home in their hearts. What are some of the practical applications of that request? In what ways can you make Christ at home in your life? How is the magnitude of Christ's love conveyed? How do vv. 14 and 19 help explain to whom Paul is referring when he states, "To Him be glory..." (v.20)?

How does this verse describe the power of God? Where is the power of God at work? In what ways is God's power demonstrated in the Church? What does God's power mean for your prayer life?

Ephesians 3:21

What does it mean to glorify God? What attributes of God are believers able to display? Read 1 Corinthians 10:31-33. How should these verses apply to what you do in the church? How can your service to the Lord display God's glory? Read Ephesians 4:1-3. How should your spirit toward other believers demonstrate the glory of God in the church? How does God's glory as demonstrated in Tri-City Baptist Church help advance the Gospel of Christ?


