#### Fifth Head of Doctrine (The Perseverance of the Saints) LORD'S DAY #50

## **REJECTION OF ERRORS**

The true doctrine having been explained, the Synod rejects the errors of those:

# Paragraph 8

Leader: Who teach: That it is not absurd that one having lost his first regeneration is again and even often born anew.

People: For these deny by this doctrine the incorruptibleness of the seed of God, whereby we are born again; contrary to the testimony of the apostle Peter: *Having been begotten again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible.*<sup>1</sup>

## Paragraph 9

Leader: Who teach: That Christ has in no place prayed that believers should infallibly continue in faith.

People: For they contradict Christ Himself, who says: *I made supplication for thee* (Simon), *that thy faith fail not*,<sup>2</sup> and the evangelist John, who declares that Christ has not prayed for the apostles only, but also for those who through their word would believe: *Holy Father, keep them in thy name, and: I pray not that thou shouldest take them from the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil one.<sup>3</sup>*
