Why?			

1) To reassure God's people that He is sovereign

2) To prepare God's people for beastly kingdoms and a world of war

3) To ensure that God's people notice the futility of earthly politics

Daniel 2:21 God changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings.

Habakkuk 2:13 Behold, is it not from the Lord of hosts that peoples labor merely for fire, and nations weary themselves for nothing?

4) To warn God's people against jumping too quickly to the conclusion that the end has come.

Matthew 24:6 (cf. Mark 13:7) And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet.
