14 Predestination is that effective exercise of the will of God by which things before determined by Him are brought to pass. See Election, 1 Pet. 1. 2, note;
 Foreknowledge, 1 Pet. 1. 20, note.
 2 Adoption (hypothesis, "placing as a son") is not so much a word of relationship as of position. The believer's relation to God as a child results from the new birth (John 1. 12, 13), whereas adoption is the act of God whereby one already a child is, through redemption from the law, placed in the position of an adult son (Gal. 4. 1-5). The indwelling Spirit gives the realization of this in the believer's present experience (Gal. 4. 6); but the full manifestation of the believer's sonship awaits the resurrection, change, and translation of saints, which is called "the redemption of the body" (Rom. 8. 23; 1 Thes. 4. 14-17; Eph. 1. 14; 1 John 3. 2).

3 The Dispensation of the Fulness of Times. This, the seventh and last of the ordered ages which condition human life on the earth, is identical with the kingdom covenantant to David (2 Sam. 7. 8-17; Zech. 12. 8, Summary; Lk. 1. 31-33; 1 Cor. 15. 24, Summary), and gathers into itself under Christ all past "times": (1) The time of oppression and misrule ends by Christ taking His kingdom (Isa. 11. 3, 4). (2) The time of testimony and divine forbearance ends in judgment (Mt. 25. 31-46; 2 Thes. 1. 6, 7). (3) The time of toil ends in rest and reward (2 Thes. 1. 11, 12; Ezk. 39. 25-29). (4) The time of suffering ends in glory (Rom. 8. 17, 18). (5) The time of Israel's blindness and chastisement ends in restoration and conversion (Rom. 11. 25-27; Eph. 3. 1-6). (6) The times of the Gentiles end in the smiting of the image and the setting up of the kingdom of the heavens (Dan. 2. 34, 35; Rev. 19. 15-21). (7) The time of creation's thralldom ends in deliverance at the manifestation of the sons of God (Gen. 3. 17; Isa. 11. 6-8; Rom. 8. 19-21).
 4 The Holy Spirit is Himself the seal. In the symbolism of Scripture a seal signifies: (1) A finished transaction (Jer. 32. 9, 10; John 17. 4; 19. 30). (2) Ownership (Jer. 32. 11, 12; 2 Tim. 2. 19). (3) Security (Eph. 8. 8; Dan. 6. 17; Eph. 4. 30).

Total Depravity - No freewill to choose Jesus Christ (means total inability) or believe the gospel
 Unconditional Election - God decided who would get saved (Rom 3:22 "unto all")
 Limited atonement - Christ's blood was shed only for the chosen (1 Joh 2:2) (2 Cor 5:14) (Nikes)
 Irresistible Grace - when God chooses, the sinner is drawn and can't stop it (Acts 7:51)
 (Perseverance of the saints) - External Security (should be perseverance of God). Gift is not irresistibly imposed.
