To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.

HOW long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

2 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?

3 Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death;

4 Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved. **Don't quit/give up**

5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation. **-Physical deliverance**

6 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me. **Proclamation of God's goodness (overflowing)**

4 Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another god: their drink offerings of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips. **Gen 9:4/Lev 17:11**

5 The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.
