

# “A Resolution for Revival”

(Mark 5:21-43)

## SERMON NOTES

The New Year’s resolution that God seeks from us is –  
*Faith in Action, that brings Revival.*

Changing our view of Jesus as more than someone we hear about on Sunday is the first step to experiencing revival.

### John 15:5-8

<sup>5</sup> I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup> If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

Revival doesn’t come by sitting in the pews and cheering on others who experience God. Revival comes by stepping into the river of living water, with faith to believe that when Jesus said, “*Ask anything in my name.*”, he meant it.

Revival is something we can begin to experience  
with this prayer:

*“Jesus bring revival – **and start in me.**”*
