In the same way, after supper he took the cup and gave thanks; he gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

Draw near with faith. Christ is the host and we are his guests.

The Apostle Paul tells us that whenever we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

Charge: Be alert! *The hour has come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed.*
