




Legs of Iron: Rust Rots

- Rome divided throughout its history; obscure origins
- Implemented admired qualities from other cultures
- From Man as the measure of all to Man is god (Ge 3:5)
- Government crumbled due to relativism: Rust
- Foundation of Western culture: U.S. to Russia



Legacy of Rome: Failure of Strength

- Romanism continues to influence straining toward a Roman globalism
 - Title of Caesar became Russian Tsar and German Kaiser
 - Medieval feudalism-serfdom grew out of Western Roman agricultural socialism
 - Through Augustine's worship of Platonism and Romanism, Roman Catholicism gained dominance and hid the true gospel during the Dark Ages
 - New nation-states were militaristic expansionistic oligarchies increasingly using democratic mob-rule to solidify socialist policies insuring return to serfdom
 - Man, the measure of all, Secularism, man as god, Evolutionism, God not needed; Socialism for the elites and Serfdom, slavery, for all others
 - Imperator worship expressed in Washington's apotheosis in America's capital
 - The Roman West influenced Europe; Roman East influenced Middle East and Eurasia into old Mesopotamia; it set the pattern for today's globalization empire



Feet of Iron & Clay: Disunity in Union

- Kingdom future to us though based on Romanesque principles
- Builds on previous kingdoms but adds unique semi-metallic, digital dimension
- History cannot define this empire; prior empires can give clues about its nature
- Interpretations focused on identifying this empire result in bizarre fantasies
- Vision defines what each empire adds to Satan's final empire; Our focus normative hermeneutical interpretation
- Bible defines Bible; as math defines math

Satan's Future Kingdom Government and Religion Together

- Satan's future kingdom, iron and clay, evidence this reliance on both religion and digital comms to captivate the world to Satan's delusion
 - Satan stands on the shore of the sea, calling for his human representative, the Antichrist who willingly submits to Satan's indwelling [Re 13:10-11:10]
 - False Prophet arises from the land receiving power from Satan promoting Antichrist's government providing messy basis supported by signs [Re 13:11-14]
 - False Prophet unites all false religions into his overarching union; Foundation: man is the measure of all focusing them on Satan's Intercessor: Antichrist
 - Idol built with the consent of the governed and, like emperor worship, all who do not pay obedience die; Again, like Roman emperor worship (iron – Bondage)
 - All who worship Antichrist, who points to Satan, are allowed to live in a centralized, rationed economy based on asebeia (ungodly) morality

Night: Satan's Domain in Power

- Daniel has much to say about this kingdom, but we will confine our study to these two verses which give a foundation for what he later writes in detail
 - Daniel reinforces concept of Night; this is the domain of Satan [Re 13:12; 17:11-12; 18:9-10]
 - This fourth beast, kingdom, arises from the sea; yet, it is more terrifying in scope
 - Four = Means completeness as this is culmination of Satan's kingdom on earth; whereas Nebuchadnezzar saw two different associated kingdoms, God shows Daniel that both are one continual kingdom: Satan's goal since Adam
 - Ten = Union of four (completeness) and six (man) is associated with law and judgment; Satan's kingdom will be based on his law, of which Hammurabi's was but an example of his mercy [Lex Talionis – Retaliation] [Dn 7:2-12]
 - Jews perverted God's Ten Words of Guidance into a terrible burden belief of mercy; it became Satan's law of slavery and death; it killed Christ to enslave all [Mt 23:16-43:15]

Leviathan: Metaphor of Satan's Kingdom

- Daniel describes this fourth beast as terrifying, dreadful and very strong
 - This beast is not directly linked to any known animal so Daniel must give a description of how powerful this beast is so we understand its metaphor
 - The previous three kingdoms were linked to men and thus given knowable animal metaphor: Lion, Bear and Cheetah
 - This kingdom is not of this world but powered by Satan whose metaphor throughout the Bible is the Dragon – Serpent – Worm (Job 3:8; 38:12-18)
 - Isaias links Satan to the Leviathan; remember, God asks Job if he is strong enough to tame the Leviathan: Beast and Satan (Accuser) (Job 41:1-41)
 - Satan, a spirit being or fallen angel, has a different nature than man, who was given God's nature; yet he wants to rule us as a god (See 2 Thess 2:14; 1 Cor 10:13; 1 Tim 2:14)
 - Leviathan probably could not survive the Postdiluvial world and died out by Daniel's day, passing into legend to become today's mythical dragon

Ten Horns:
Union of Kingdoms

- Horns are metaphors for power (Control). In this instance, governmental power or kingdoms which:
 - Are based on Satan's law of Lex Talionis; unmerciful in its judgment
 - Permeates every worldly kingdom from a common source (One Body)
 - Appears strong but managed to prevent mutual destruction (MAD)
 - May correlate to ten governments or simply denotes Satan's completeness
 - Small Horn arises which is given eyes like a man making it different from the other horns which have no such characteristics: blind followers
 - Horn speaks to dominates its subjects but does not three horns leaving seven horns which follow it: seven is perfection; completeness of control
 - Smallness denotes deception as it is most powerful leader, able to completely dominate the large horns to form a more perfect union

Small Horn: Power Unto Itself – From Satan



- Small horn derives its power directly from Satan.
 - This is another facet of the Antichrist who comes from the sea with ten horns
 - Satan always works behind the scenes until it is time to strike, then he strikes **hard**
 - While people fixate on power of governments; governments **totally** dependent on finances [Governments produce nothing; Follow the Money – Root of all Evil (11:12)]
 - Love of Money is Love of Control which is enmity against God (16:14)
 - Alexander Megos squandered his great hoard of Persian gold, dumping it on the open market; He knew military power but was ignorant of true power: Fiscal
 - Roman military power was axiomatic but variable; true source of their empire's longevity was constant source of fiscal power: Saxon/Baement gold mines
 - Rome's power waned as the basis of their monetary system waned; gold and silver; revised empire's financial tier will fuel its corporate-government control

Satan's Finiteness Closed Pie System: Socialism–Distributing Equality by Force

- God is infinite: He can give to everyone as much as He determines they need since He cannot be exhausted (Exodus 33:19; Hebrews 1:3; 2 Peter 1:19)

 - Satan is a created being and cannot create anything; hence, he must do with what is available – Finite: This is the heart of socialism's fixed pie mentality (Matthew 25:14-30)
 - Sinners reject the infinite God to embrace the fallen finite being who rules by violence and degradation (John 14:20; 1 John 2:17; 1 John 4:4; 1 John 5:19-20)
 - Satan rations what God freely gives using the criteria of equality to determine who is worthy to receive...This is the reality of Socialism: Eternity is a long time

- God made this creation temporary; Satan and his governments seek to rule here forever except there is no forever (Proverbs 13:13; Hebrews 10:27-28)
 - No one escapes judgment; Christ faced judgment for the saved: Lost will face judgment without Christ based on their works (Matthew 10:28)

Insanity: Doing Same Thing; Expecting Different

- Satan does not change; he simply changes the setting and uses more refined techniques; he is trapped by his angelic nature and sin (Ezekiel 28:1-19)
 - This final kingdom of the four represents Satan's ultimate and unvanquished effort to establish his ultimate kingdom
 - Small horn represents the head of a union of subordinate kingdoms; those who rebel are dramatically removed, ripped up by their roots.
 - Satan mimics Christ but but cannot achieve a comparable kingdom as he is finite while Christ is infinite; due to sin's insecurity Satan responds with anger and force to control rebellious, sinful, mankind [Probably why he wants population control, and to eke out the resources for the elites (Eugenics!)]
 - Satan's laws of control reject God's Moral Law; they are relative to himself and they change being based on lies: God's Law is absolute, immutable (1 Peter 1:18)

Last Days: Satan on Earth Establishing His Union

- With Christ's death, resurrection and ascension, Satan was cast to earth; he knows his time is short; i.e., predetermined or unchangeable (Revelation 20:1-3; Hebrews 10:12)

 - He is working with ever increasing levels of violence and death to ready his confederated empire before Christ's imminent but unknowable return (Matthew 24:4-13)
 - Thus, these are called the Latter or Last Days; coincides with Day of the Lord (Revelation 11:2; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-10)
 - Day of the Lord is a process of judgment that begins upon His return to establish His Millennial Kingdom and ends with this creation melting by fire
 - Work as hard as he will, Satan and all sinners will not avail but show themselves worthy of their fiery judgment; Love of money-power condemns them (Matthew 25:1-4)
 - Christians who focus on the world run the risk of losing their real love, Christ, because of Satan's seeming invincibility; where else can we go but to Christ; Who else has the words of life? Yet, lost will fall away to hell (Matthew 13:24-30; 25:41)
