

1 Corinthians 6 (12-26-10)

GOD IS FOR YOUR BODY!

TEXT: 1 Corinthians 6:13 Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord; **and the Lord for the body.**

14 And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power.

19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Jude 1:10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but **what they know naturally**, as **brute beasts**, in those things they corrupt themselves.

...and the Lord for the body.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge...

1 Corinthians 11:30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Ephesians 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

Job 23:12 Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food.
