**Title: “Tall, Dark & Handsome & Insecure” 1 Samuel 9:1-2**

**Question Set #1** Are there areas in my life where I am insecure? Is my insecurity sporadic or a consistent challenge or liability? What can be done about this in my life? How do I gain confidence? Can I use someone else to help me?

**Question Set #2** What is the root cause of my insecurity? Do I have unfinished business concerning that “root”? Am I in need of counseling and if so how do I feel about that? If you are opposed to counseling, is it rooted in insecurity?

**Question Set #3** Are there people in my life that deal with insecurity? How can I encourage them or minister to them?

**Question Set #4** Did Jesus ever deal with insecurity in others? If so, how so? Who? What context?

**Action Step:** Check out King Saul starting with 1 Samuel 8 and subsequent chapters. What can be learned from this interesting character. Consider taking the Faithful Men challenge if you are not already. Consider talking to someone concerning any areas of immobilizing insecurity.
