- Introduction: The relevance of Deuteronomy to prosperity in our day.
Why study Deuteronomy?
1. Christ quoted verse 3 as an imperative for Kingdom living in Matthew 4:4.
 2. Christ quoted from Deuteronomy more frequently than from any other book.
 3. 1 Corinthians 10:11. Romans 15:4
 4. Deuteronomy is directly quoted in the New Testament 79 times and with over two hundred allusions. Example: Ephesians 6:2-3
Sample curses in the New Testament: Deut. 27:26; 29:4,18; 32:21,35,36,43
 5. Sample blessings Deut 30:13-14; 31:6; 32:43),
