- I. Inadequate signs of success:
 - A. Great Interest In The Pastor and his message (v. 30a)
 - B. Witnessing (v. 30b)
 - C. Faithful Attendance (v. 31a)
 - D. Understanding (v. 32b)
 - E. Expression of devotion and love (v. 31b)
 - F. Enjoying the Services
- II. What God is looking for:
 - A. Heart Transformation (v. 31b)
 - 1. A mind totally submitted to God's Word. (Their mind had not yet been subject to the Spirit.)
 - 2. A will subject to God's desires. (Their will still lacked submission to God.)
 - 3. Affections oriented away from self-serving to God. (Their affections were still attached to the creature rather than to the Creator.)
 - B. Holiness (vv. 31,32)
