THE ANGEL OF THE LORD

There is a special angel in the Old Testament and we are going to talk a bit about that. He is *the Angel of the Lord*. In the Old Testament, I believe the Angel of the Lord was the Lord Jesus Christ Himself, before He ever was here on earth. In the New Testament, it is usually phrased: “*an Angel of the Lord.*”

ANGELS DO NOT EXALT THEMSELVES

Angels have been ministering to those who are the heirs of salvation down through the corridors of time—in the Old Testament and in the New Testament. The angels’ ministry is not to exalt themselves—not that the Father says to them, “Sit at my right hand,” as He says to the Lord Jesus Christ, His Son—but they are ministering spirits sent forth to minister to them who shall be heirs of salvation.
