۱.	Why Is Your Perseverance as a Believer in Christ Not Required for Eternal Salvation?
	1. Because there is only Savior of humanity, the Lord Jesus Christ. (Isa. 43:11; 45:21-22; John 14:6 Acts 4:12; 1 Tim. 2:4-5)
	2. Because of the principle that salvation is or or to the Lord. (Ps. 3:8; 68:20; Jon. 2:9; Rev. 7:10)
	3. Because of the many verses the of God the Father or Jesus Christ saving, keeping, and preserving, rather than believers keeping themselves saved through perseverance. (John 6:39; 10:28-29; 17:11-12; Rom. 5:9-10; 8:29-30; 8:34; 2 Tim. 1:12; 4:18; Heb. 7:25)
	4. Because at the exact a sinner first in Christ, God completes several instantaneous and irreversible transactions on our behalf: the Holy Spirit permanently regenerates us (Titus 3:5), indwells us (John 14:16), baptizes us into Christ's own body (1 Cor. 12:12-13), seals us in Christ (Eph. 1:13). God also adopts us (Eph. 1:5), forgives us (Col. 2:13), justifies us (Rom. 5:1), reconciles us (2 Cor. 5:19), redeems us (Eph. 1:7), gives us everlasting life in Christ (Rom. 6:23), and guarantees our future bodily resurrection and glorification (Rom. 8:18-23).
	5. Because Jesus illustrated belief in Him for eternal life with a single, momentary act of
	(John 3:14-15); (John 4:13-15); or (John 6:31-35, 47-51).
	6. Because the adjective ( <i>pistos</i> ) occurs 67x in the New Testament but is never used as the condition for eternal life in contrast to its noun "faith" ( <i>pistis</i> ) and verb "believe" ( <i>pisteuo</i> ) forms.
	7. Because the New Testament describes believers as possessing eternal life that can never be lost; yet it also says it's possible for you as believer to
