Westminster Larger Catechism Question #49

Q. 49 How did Christ humble himself in his death?

A. Christ humbled Himself in His death, in that having been betrayed by Judas (1) forsaken by his disciples(2), scorned and rejected by the world (3), condemned by Pilate, and tormented by his persecutors (4); having also conflicted with the terrors of death, and the powers of darkness, felt and borne the weight of God's wrath (5), he laid down his life an offering for sin (6), enduring the painful, shameful, and cursed death of the cross.(7)

¹ *Matthew 27:4* — *Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.*

² *Matthew 26:56* — *But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.*

³ *Isaiah 53:2-3* — *For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.³ He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.*

⁴ *Matthew 27:26-50* — *Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified, (including the rest of the verses). *John 19:34* — *But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.**

⁵ *Luke 22:44* — *And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground. *Matthew 27:46* — *And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?**

⁶ *Isaiah 53:10* — *Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.*

⁷ *Philippians 2:8* — *And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.*

Hebrews 12:2 — *Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. *Galatians 3:13* — *Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.**

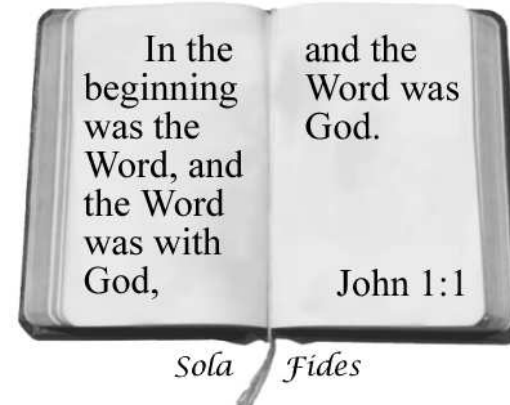
