Review:

Lots of names, lots of places, and lots of history. Why should we care? Because God does. He is the author of history, and it's exciting to see how He providentially brings his plans to pass. While we won't take time in this handout to review the specific history, let's take some time to meditate on and think through application for the three truths Pastor Conley called our attention to.

3 Great Truths:

1. God reveals truth.
2. God rules history.
3. God rescues his people.

Application:

1. Why is it significant that God would reveal truth? What if God hadn't revealed truth? Are we able to come up with absolute truth without God? What is the greatest truth God has revealed? How/where has he revealed it? What have you personally done with that truth? Have you shared it with anyone else?
2. Is there such a thing as "coincidence?" If God rules history then what does that mean when there are people in authority that we don't agree with? How is the knowledge that God is ruling in history a great comfort to us? When have there been some other times in history that would have been easy to doubt God's "rulership?"
3. Does God always rescue his people? Does He rescue every single person here on earth every time? Does God deliver his people in an "ultimate" sense every time?
