

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The Promise of a Coming Redeemer
 - The promised seed
 - Gen. 3:15 - the seed of the woman
 - Gen. 12:1-3 - the seed of Abraham
 - Gen. 49:10 - the tribe of Judah
 - 2 Sam. 7:12-17 - the seed of David
- The Redeemer has Come
 - The promised seed
 - Gal. 4:4 – born of a woman
 - Gal. 3:16 – seed of Abraham
 - Rev. 5:5 – tribe of Judah
 - Rom. 1:3 – seed of David

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promised Prophet,
Priest and King
 - Deut. 18:15 -a Prophet greater than Moses
 - Psa. 2 - a King who would rule the nations
 - Psa. 110 - a King-Priest

- The promised Prophet,
Priest and King
 - Acts 3:21-23
 - Rev. 1:5
 - Heb. 7

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promised Servant of the Lord
 - Isa. 42:1-4; 52:13-53:12
 - Matt. 12:15-21; Acts 8:25-35
- The promised Savior-God
 - Isa. 7:14; 9:6; 40:3-5
 - Matt. 1:21-23; Mk. 1:1-3

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promise of the Kingdom of God
 - There would be a coming Kingdom, associated with Messiah
 - Dan. 2:44-45; 7:13-14
- The Kingdom of God has come
 - 1 Cor. 15:25; Col. 1:16-18
 - Matt. 28:18; Acts 2:36

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promise of the New Covenant inaugurated
- Jer. 31:31-34
- The New Covenant has been inaugurated
- Lk. 22:20; Heb. 8

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promise of the Restoration of Israel and the Inclusion and Salvation of the Gentiles
- Jer. 3:14-18; 23:1-6; Isa. 9:1; 11:10-16; 19:18-24; 56:6-8; Mal. 1:11; Psa. 67:87; Ezek. 47:22
- Israel is being restored and the Gentiles are a part of the Israel of God
 - Acts 2; Eph. 2:11-22; 1 Pet. 2:9-10; Heb. 12:22-24

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promise of the Outpouring of the Spirit
 - Joel 2:28-32
- The Holy Spirit has been poured out.
 - Acts 2:16, 33; Eph. 1:13-14

Old Testament Promise New Testament Fulfillment

- The promise of a New Heaven and a New Earth
 - Isa. 35:1-2, 7; 65:17; 66:22
- This re-creation will be the inheritance of God's people and the fulfillment of God's promise to Abraham.
- The Promise of a New Heaven and a New Earth is inaugurated, but not consummated.
 - Rom. 8:18-25; 2 Cor. 5:17; Gal. 6:15; 2 Pet. 3:13; Rev. 21-22
 - Rom. 4:13
