**1 Timothy 2:5** For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, **6** who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time. Men who would go before the false gods and try to work out an agreement between the false gods and the people with Church leaders not wanting to create a disturbance.

**Characteristic #1** Made by God Completed by God. **8a, 10a**

**Characteristic #2** Made with Israel. **8b, 10a**

**Characteristic #3** Not an extension of revision of the Old **9a 13**

**Characteristic #4** Was not conditional.
