John 6:22-35

Review:

“I am the Bread of Life”-- these are part of the last words of Jesus to those in the region of Galilee. Remember these people were not used to four-course meals and all you can eat buffets. Bread was the main staple of their regular diet. It was what they needed to stay alive.

Application:

1. How does the context of this passage give us insight into why Jesus used the “bread” picture?
2. We live in a world of unsatisfied desires. The bread of this world “spoils.” What are some things that our sinful hearts attempt to find “temporary” satisfaction in?
3. Heaven provided only “one” solution for man’s condition. Jesus declares that He was “sent” from heaven. How would you respond to someone who said that all religions lead to God? How does the world respond to Christianity’s exclusive claims?
4. What is the difference between someone with a passing interest in Jesus and a satisfied partaker of the “Bread of Life?”
5. Physical bread aids only in temporal life but not eternal. How does the knowledge of eternal life affect our life right now?
6. We do not know when we will receive our final appeal. When did you receive Him?
