1 Thessalonians 2:13, Acts 17:1-12

Review:

This passage shows us how Paul followed Christ and opened his life up to others. This type of life requires self denial, to forget about ourselves and dedicate ourselves to a cause that is bigger than we are. That Cause is the *Gospel!*
