Genesis 29:1-30 God's Refinement of Jacob Begins January 26, 2022

1 Pet. 1:6-7.

In our last study of Gen. 28:10-22 we saw the beginning of Jacob's journey to Haran.

- Jacob was running for his life.
- Jacob journeyed through potential dangers as he made a journey by himself that he had never taken before.
- In this hard and dangerous place God graciously revealed Himself. Verses 13-15.
- In these words, God established the covenant with Jacob.
- Jacob had a compromised response to God's gracious revelation.

In tonight's passage we begin to study a 20-year period in God's refinement of Jacob which will be a lifelong process that will transform Jacob from the one who grabs the heel to the one who Heb. 11:21 says that "...when dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, bowing in worship over the head of his staff."

- We should trust in the Lord as He refines us, **1 Pet. 1:6-7, Jam. 1:2-4**.
