1 The order is: (1) the declaration of title, "The earth is the LORD'S" (vs. 1, 2). (2) Who shall rule the earth? (vs. 3-6). It is a question of worthiness, and no one is worthy but the Lamb. Cf. Dan. 7, 13, 14; Rev. 5, 3-10; Mt. 25, 31. (3) The King of glory takes the throne of earth (vs. 7-10). See Psa. 40., next in order of the Messianic Psalms.
