<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

**QUESTION # 78: WHENCE ARISETH THE IMPERFECTION OF SANCTIFICATION IN BELIEVERS?**

**ANSWER:**

THE IMPERFECTION OF SANCTIFICATION IN BELIEVERS ARISETH FROM THE REMNANTS OF SIN ABIDING IN EVERY PART OF THEM, AND THE PERPETUAL LUSTINGS OF THE FLESH AGAINST THE SPIRIT; WHEREBY THEY ARE OFTEN FOILED WITH TEMPTATIONS, AND FALL INTO MANY SINS,<sup>A</sup> ARE HINDERED IN ALL THEIR SPIRITUAL SERVICES,<sup>B</sup> AND THEIR BEST WORKS ARE IMPERFECT AND DEFILED IN THE SIGHT OF GOD.<sup>C</sup>
