SERMON: BOOKS ABOUT CHRIST: EXODUS, THE WAY

- I. Genesis lays the foundation:
 - A. The prophecy and promise of Genesis 15: 12-21
 - B. Joseph and the sojourn in Egypt: Genesis 41:38-49; 42:1-3; 45:4ff., 47:27-31; 50:15-21; 24-26; Exodus 1:8ff.
 - C. From multitude to servitude: Exodus 1
- II. Exodus: the WAY
 - A. Exodus = Greek for the "way or road out"
 - B. The Way OUT (of Egypt): the fulfillment of God's promise to Abraham
 1. The call of Moses (Exodus 2-4)
 2. The call to Pharaoh: Let My people go! (Exodus 5-6)
 3. The first nine plagues (Exodus 7-10)
 4. The last plague: the killing of the firstborn (Exodus 11-12)
 5. The Passover (Exodus 12-13)
 6. Pharaoh's last stand (Exodus 15)
 7. Free at last, free at last....(Exodus 15)
 - C. The Way OF God: His grace, Law and Covenant (Exodus 16-24)
 1. Theophany: cloud by day, pillar of fire by night (Exodus 13:21-22)
 2. Giving water, manna, meat and fatherly counsel (chapters 16-18)
 3. The Ten Commandments and other laws (Exodus 19-23)
 4. The Sabbath and the feasts of celebration (Exodus 23)
 5. The blood of the (old) covenant (Exodus 24)
 - D. The Way TO God: The Tabernacle (Exodus 25-40)
 1. God's blueprint, God's command (Exodus 25:9,40: 26:30)
 2. The Ark of the Covenant at the center (Exodus 25:10-22)
 3. The other components: table, lampstand, veil, altar (Exodus 25-27)
 4. The Aaronic priesthood and the sacrifices (Exodus 28-30)
 5. The builders: called by God (Exodus 31)
 6. The need for a mediator: the golden calf (Exodus 32-34)
 7. Construction and completion (Exodus 35-40)
 8. The glory of the LORD: God with His redeemed people (40:34-38)
- III. Exodus is all about Jesus: The Way, the Truth and the Life (John 14:6)
 - A. He is "I AM" of Exodus 3, the manna of Exodus 16 (John 6:31-35; 48-51)
 - B. He is the Passover Lamb who takes away the sin of the world (I Cor. 5:7)
 - C. He is the Great High Priest of the order of Melchizedek of whom Aaron and his sons were but types and shadows (Hebrews 7)
 - D. He is the table of showbread, the lampstand and the veil (Heb. 10:19-22)
 - E. Moses, a servant in God's house. Jesus is the Son of the house (Heb. 3:1-6)
 - F. He is the Mediator of the New Covenant, consecrated by His blood (Matthew 26:28; Mark 14:24; Luke 22:20; Hebrews 9:15-28)
 - G. His glory is the glory of the living and eternal God (John 1:14)
 - H. He is Immanuel = God with us (Matthew 1:23; 28:20)
 - I. He alone is the Way out of bondage to sin, the Way into God's house
 - J. Exodus is all about the Lord of Glory (I Cor. 2:8), and His Supper
