I. The Rewards or Benefits of Wisdom (3:1-12)

Five Imperatives in the text from vv 1-10

1. vv. 1-2: *Forget not*,
2. vv. 3-4: *Let not*
3. vv. 5-6: *Trust and lean not*
4. vv. 7-8: *Be not*

I. #5 Imperative: “Honor and Hoard not” vv 9-10

“Honor the Lord with Your Possessions”

“So your barns will be filled with plenty”

(Ex. 22:29; 23:19; 34:20; Lev. 23:10; Lev 25: 23; Deut 8:18; 2 Cor 16:2)

II. Embrace the Lord’s Discipline (vv.11-12)

(Heb 5:8; 12:6-11; Rev 3:19-21)
