I. The whole thing had been planned from the beginning

Gen 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Jer 31:22 ...the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man.

Isa 7:14 ... a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel

II. At God's appointed time—God sent forth His Son to save His people

Gal 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

Gal 4:5 To redeem them that were under the law...

A. The angel Gabriel came to tell Mary

- Luk 1:31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.
- Luk 1:32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
- Luk 1:33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.
- Luk 1:34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?
- Luk 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

B. The angel of the Lord came to tell Joseph

Mat 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

- Mat 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
- Mat 1:22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,
- Mat 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.
- Mat 1:24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:
- Mat 1:25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

C. The birth of the promised Jesus

- Luk 2:7 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.
- Luk 2:8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.
- Luk 2:9 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.
- Luk 2:10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.
- Luk 2:11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord...
- Luk 2:13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,
- Luk 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

II. The Biblical idea of 'Fetch Um'

A. 'Fetch him' — Mephibosheth

- 2Sa 9:1 And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may shew him kindness for Jonathan's sake? ...
- 2Sa 9:3 ... And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan hath yet a son, which is lame on his feet.
- 2Sa 9:4 And the king said unto him, Where *is* he? And Ziba said unto the king, Behold, he *is* in the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, in Lodebar.
- 2Sa 9:5 Then king David sent, and fetched him...
- 2Sa 9:13 So Mephibosheth...did eat continually at the king's table...

B. 'Fetch her' —The aborted (miscarried) discarded little baby girl

- Eze 16:4 And *as for* thy nativity, in the day thou wast born thy navel was not cut, neither wast thou washed in water to supple *thee*; thou wast not salted at all, nor swaddled at all.
- Eze 16:5 None eye pitied thee, to do any of these unto thee, to have compassion upon thee; but thou wast cast out in the open field, to the lothing of thy person, in the day that thou wast born.

- Eze 16:6 And when I passed by thee, and saw thee polluted in thine own blood, I said unto thee *when thou wast* in thy blood, Live; yea, I said unto thee *when thou wast* in thy blood, Live.
- Eze 16:7 I have caused thee to multiply...thy breasts are fashioned, and thine hair is grown, whereas thou *wast* naked and bare.
- Eze 16:8 Now when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time *was* the time of love; and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness: yea, I... entered into a covenant with thee, saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest mine.

C. 'Fetch him' —Saul of Tarsus

- Act 9:1 And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples...
- Act 9:3 And as he journeyed...suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:
- Act 9:4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?
- Act 9:5 And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks.
- Act 9:6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? ...

III. Throughout history and still—Jesus 'fetches um' individually—One at a time

- 1Ti 1:16 Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.
- Joh 5:25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

IV. At the cross—Jesus 'fetched um' individually—At one time—One sin at a time

A. God sent forth His Son to 'fetch um' —(And He will 'fetch um')

- Gal 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
- Gal 4:5 To redeem them that were under the law...
- Mat 1:21 ...thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
- Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- Heb 2:13 ...Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

B. God 'fetched um' all at one time—Yet individually—One sin at a time

- Psa 51:9 Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.
- Isa 43:25 I, even I, am he that blotteth out **thy** transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember **thy** sins.

C. Every sin of every individual is marked

- Psa 130:3 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?
- Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
- Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
- Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

D. Jesus had to mark and blot out each individual sin of each individual child

- Jas 2:10 For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in **one** *point*, he is guilty of all.
- Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.
- Gal 3:10 ...for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.
- Ecc 12:14 For God shall bring **every work** into judgment, with **every secret thing**, whether *it be* good, or whether *it be* evil.
- Mat 12:36 But I say unto you, That **every idle word** that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

E. Jesus blotted out many sins and offences

- Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;
- Rom 5:16 And not as *it was* by one that sinned, *so is* the gift: for the judgment *was* by one to condemnation, but **the free gift** *is* **of many offences unto justification**.

V. Nothing can keep any individual Jesus died for from being fetched in the end

- Rom 8:33 Who shall lay any **thing** to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth.
- Rom 5:9 ...being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

VI. Each one that God fetched individually—One at a time—Will be glorified

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

VII. Each one that God fetched individually—All at one time—Will be glorified

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
